Sailing in Cockburn Sound to continue

 Recreational and competitive sailing has and will continue to co-exist with port operations.

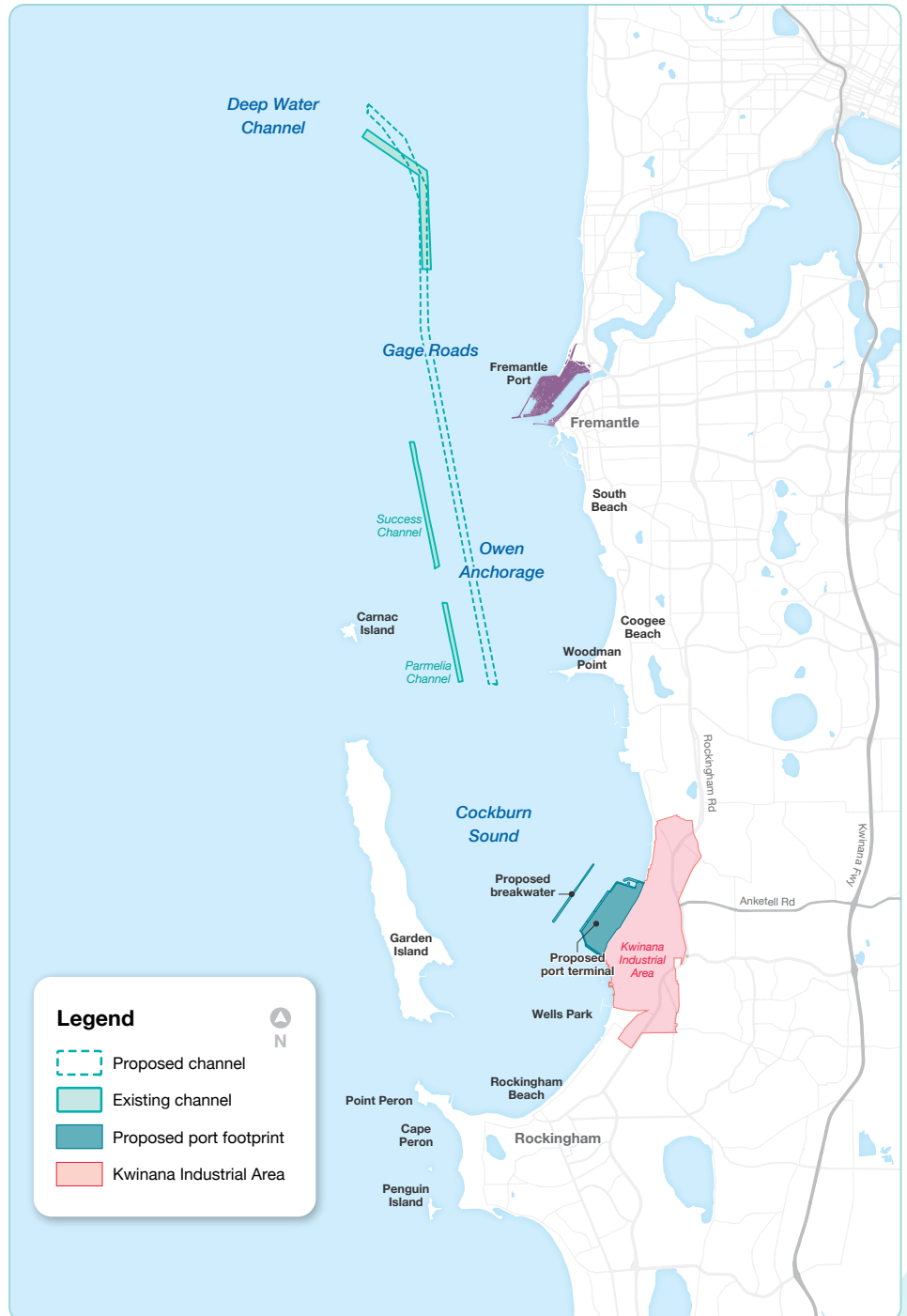
 Once the port is operational, some areas in the immediate port terminal vicinity may not be accessible. However, these areas are likely to be relatively small and the surrounding waters outside the port will remain open for sailing activities.

 Race events are currently managed by the Fremantle Ports' Harbour Master and monitored in real time.

 Racing safety and communications will continue to be assessed annually by Fremantle Ports in collaboration with Yachting Australia.

 Westport is working closely with Fremantle Ports in the planning for the new infrastructure in Kwinana, which is not expected to be operational until at least the late 2030s.

Westport will support long-term recreation in Cockburn Sound and work with community to ensure this development meets economic, environmental and community objectives.
