# Anketell-Thomas Road Freight Corridor Planning

What is happening with Anketell and Thomas Roads?

Westport together with Main Roads has started early planning on the Anketell- Thomas Road freight corridor which will connect the port with Tonkin Highway and will support wider growth of the south eastern suburbs.

Whilst the final land requirement and road design is yet to be finalised, Westport is talking to the community about the project as early as possible about the early concept design for the road freight network.

## What is a Planning Control Area (PCA)?

A Planning Control *Area* is intended to be used to identify the area needed for the future road and ensure proposed developments in the area support the future road freight corridor.

Planning Control Areas are used to identify land for future public purposes, such as major roads, intersections, interchanges and drainage.

All landowners directly affected by the proposed Planning Control Area will be contacted by the Westport Office to discuss what it means for them.

## Why are Planning Control Areas (PCAs) used?

PCAs protect land required for state purposes until it may be reserved in the Metropolitan Region Scheme (MRS).

PCAs are implemented where required to ensure that no development occurs on the affected land that might prejudice its future identified purpose (in this case the Anketell Thomas Road freight corridor.

#### Does this mean my house/land will be acquired or purchased?

At this stage of planning, specific land requirements within the PCA have not been confirmed.



Any affected landowners will be contacted directly to discuss their options. We will keep affected landowners informed as the corridor designs and land requirements are finalised.

#### What if I want to sell my house now?

Any landowners within the PCA are welcome to contact the Westport office to discuss their personal circumstances.
